Identical letters dated 17 June 2022 from the Permanent Representative of Iraq to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General and the President of the Security Council

On instructions from my country's Government, I transmit to you herewith a summary of violations of Iraqi territory and airspace perpetrated by Turkey between 1 September 2021 and 1 January 2022 (see annex).

I should also like to draw your attention to the following:

These violations of the sovereignty of Iraq by Turkey are contrary to the principles of good-neighbourliness and constitute a violation of the principles of the Charter of the United Nations and international law.

My Government reiterates its willingness to cooperate with its neighbour Turkey with a view to finding common ground and arriving at peaceful solutions that will bring an end to these repeated violations.

I should be grateful if the present letter and its annex could be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
